But do not ignore this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like one day.

2 Peter 3:8

No getting around it: we humans, as a species, mark time. Clocks, calendars... all of it to measure, take note of, pay attention to... *time*. It's one of the things, I suppose, that separates us from the rest of the created order. Maybe that's why we, as a species, seem to be, generally, a lot more anxious and neurotic than the rest of the created order! My cat doesn't wear a watch, and he seems pretty content. Then again, all he does is lay around in sunbeams, cuss us out when his bowl is empty and then alternates the rest of the day between sleeping and licking himself.

We, on the other hand, have things to do. And these things must be juggled, balanced and fit in to a finite amount of *time* that is relentlessly marching on. At least, that's the way it can feel to us, particularly when we're harried or hurried or just plain worn out. Kind of ominous, isn't it? Like the opening to one of the soap operas my mom used to watch: "*As sands through the hourglass... so are the days of our lives.*"

But there is another way to look at time. Not simply as something running out, but as a gift imparted... a grace of history illuminating where we've been, making us who we are today and empowering us for the day at hand. This is what anniversaries are about: occasions to mark time in thanksgiving for the gift of time itself... time spent with another (like a wedding anniversary) or time spent engaged in a certain endeavor (like a work anniversary).

We have a couple of special anniversaries to observe here at Our Savior's Lutheran Church this summer, and both are occasions for thanksgiving:

This June will mark the 25th anniversary of Julie Lee serving as our Office Administrator and bookkeeper. Julie has helped this office function for a quarter of a century now, and that ain't nothin'.

Later this summer, we mark the 25th anniversary of Laura Campbell's work among us as our Deacon. (Apparently 1996 was a banner year for hiring here at OSLC☺) Laura's on sabbatical until early July, and her presently empty, quiet office is a vivid reminder to me and to many of how integral she is to the mission of this congregation.

I would imagine that for both Julie and Laura, they've had days among us that felt like a thousand years. But I'd bet cash money that as they look back over the last quarter century, taken all together, it can seem like a single day gone past. That's how it is when you're engaged in the lives of people you care about.

As one who works with Julie and Laura on a daily basis, I'd rip off this thought from the apostle Paul in his letter to the Philippians:

I thank my God every time I think of you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. (Philippians 1:3 – 5)



Esther Circle encourages anyone to donate a kit or individual articles and place in the basket near the receptionist desk in the Fellowship Hall.

Each kit should contain:

- 2 long or short-sleeved gowns or sleepers (without feet)
- 1 hand towel, dark color recommended,
- 2 receiving blankets,
- 2 lightweight cotton t-shirts,
- 4 cloth diapers,
- 2 pairs of socks
- 2 bath-size bars of gentle soap, in original wrapping
- 2 diaper pins,
- 1 jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood or include a baby cap

*Wrap items in one of the receiving blankets and secure with the safety pins. Gently used, clean items can be substituted for new ones. **An entire kit gets kind of expensive, single items really help as well.** Do not enclose kit in plastic bags.*


